

Development firm plans 16-story apartment tower in Uptown Dallas

An apartment complex development firm — headed by former **Gables Residential** executives [Doug Chesnut](#) and [Tom Bakewell](#) — has bought a two-building office complex at Carlisle and Bowen streets in Uptown Dallas on a site where it plans to [construct a 16-story apartment tower](#), according to an article in the *Dallas Morning News*.

The two-story office building will be demolished to allow for the construction of the high-rise residential project, which will have about 300 units.

StreetLights Residential was formed earlier this year when Chesnut and Bakewell left Gables Residential, according to the report.
